

Healthy North East Derbyshire Partnership Small Grants Scheme 2017 /18

Derbyshire County Council Public Health Department has set up a small grants scheme in each of its locality areas to help support local groups and communities improve the health and wellbeing of local residents.

Groups can submit requests for grants up to £3000

Who can apply?

You could be a voluntary / community group or even a group of local people within the North East Derbyshire District Council area, who come together to support the health and wellbeing of their community. For example, your group might be a luncheon club, a social group, a self-help group or another type of community group that provides help and support. You might want to set up a new group to meet a local need that's currently not being addressed.

We want to hear from people who'd like to make a difference to their community. It doesn't matter if your group doesn't have formal constitution or working rules, or you are a just group of people with a good idea; don't let it stop you applying! Speak with NDVA for advice and if the application is successful they can support you to deliver your project.

Thursday 11th January 2018**

All successful applicants will be expected to complete a short End of Project Report.

The grant scheme will be administered by NDVA.
